1. Do you currently have a cough, fever or difficulty breathing?
2. Have you had close contact with a laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 person in the past 14 days?
3. Have you traveled in the past 14 days, or have you had contact with anyone who had cough, fever, or difficulty breathing following travel to another location?

Staying Safe

We are advising our patients to remain thoughtful about where they need to go and reduce unnecessary community exposure. In addition, we have developed materials on preventative measures that our patients can take to reduce the risks of exposure to respiratory viruses.
